

Marriage vows – Multiple

Options

In weddings done by Kola you have the option of choosing how you would like to do your marriage vows

1. The marriage officer asks whether you promise to (marriage vow) and you say “I DO”
2. You write your own marriage vows (or choose from the one below) and the marriage officer reads it, and your repeat it after him, while looking your partner in the eyes
3. You write your own marriage vows (or choose) and reads or recites it to your partner.

In order to assist you in making your day extra-special, we have included a number of options you can use when saying your vows to each other and when giving and receiving your rings. You may choose any of the options or you can mix and match ideas as you please. You may also feel that you wish to write your own vows for each other, in which case you are free to do so as long as they are acceptable to the marriage officer and provided to him prior to the service.

Declaration of Marriage Vows

OPENING STATEMENT

Dearly Beloved: We are gathered here, in the presence of God and of this company, that **ANDREW** and **ELIZABETH** may be united in holy matrimony. We are here to celebrate and share in the glorious act that God is about to perform - the act by which He converts their love for one another into the holy and sacred estate of marriage.

This relationship is an honorable and sacred one, established by our Creator for the welfare and happiness of humankind, and approved by the Apostle Paul as honorable among all men. It is designed to unite two sympathies and hopes into one; and it rests upon the mutual confidence and devotion of husband and wife.

May it be in extreme thoughtfulness and reverence, and in dependence upon divine guidance, that you enter now into this holy relationship."

DECLARATION OF INTENTION

"The apostle Paul compared the relationship between husband and wife to that between Christ and the church. Marriage is a decision of two individuals to share the same type of pure, Christian love described by Paul."

1 Corinthians 13:4-8, Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. It is not rude, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, and it keeps no record of wrongs. Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, and always perseveres. Love never fails....

2. **LESLEY** do you declare that, as far as you know, there is no lawful impediment against your proposed marriage to **ROBIN**. Do you accept all those present as witnesses that you are taking him as your lawfully wedded husband? What is your answer?

GROOM & BRIDE: “Yes”

Groom answers: I do

3. BRIDE

LESLEY do you take **ROBIN** to be your husband, to live together according to the instructions in God's Word? Do you promise to love him, comfort him, honor and keep him in times of health and in sickness and forsaking all other men, do you promise to be totally committed to him as long as you both shall live?

Bride answers: I do

ROBIN in the presence of God and all these witnesses, make your vows to **LESLEY** by saying after me:

"I, **ROBIN**, take thee, **LESLEY**, to be my wedded wife, to have and to hold, from this day forward, for better, for worse, for richer, for poorer in sickness and in health, to love and to cherish, till death do us part. According to God's holy ordinance, and thereto I pledge thee my faith."

LESLEY in the presence of God and all these witnesses, make your vows to **ROBIN** by saying after me:

"I, **LESLEY**, take thee, **ROBIN**, to be my wedded husband. to have and to hold, from this day forward, for better, for worse, for richer, for poorer, in sickness and in health, to love and to cherish, till death do us part. According to God's holy ordinance, and thereto I pledge thee my faith."

4. RINGS:

The Bride & Bridegroom will now confirm their vows by the giving of a ring, the token and pledge of their love and allegiance to each other.

"It is a Christian custom to exchange rings as a symbol of love.

As the rings have no end so, your love should have no end. As the rings are made of gold symbolizing purity, so should your marriage have purity. As often as either of you see them, you will be reminded of this moment and the endless love you promised."

GROOM AND BRIDE REPEAT

This ring symbolizes the unending union of my life with yours. Your dreams are now my dreams, Your hopes are my hopes. Your fears are my concerns. Your affection is my joy, Your love is my blessing.

DECLARATION OF THE MARRIAGE

"What therefore God hath joined together, let no man put asunder. Forasmuch as **ROBIN** and **LESLEY** have consented together in holy matrimony, and have witnessed the same before God and this company and have pledged their love and loyalty to each other, and have declared the same by the joining and the giving of rings, I, therefore, pronounce that you are husband and wife, in the name of The Father and The Son and The Holy Spirit."
