Unity Rituals

Kola offers 3 different types of unity rituals to enhance your wedding experience. These rituals are not compulsory but is especially beneficial for second marriages where children are present & new families are created.

1.) TIE HANDS WITH A RIBBON:

This ancient tradition involves the tying of a ribbon around the joined hands of the bride & groom as a symbol of their new unity.

2.) CANDLE CEREMONY:

Parents of the bride & groom are invited to each light a candle as a symbol of the life they have given to their children. After the marriage vows the bride and groom light a new candle together as a symbol of their new life together.

3.) SAND RITUAL:

The bride and groom and any children who now forms part of the new family are invited to each take part. Each member will take a personal glass/vessel filled a distinctive colour sand and respectively pour it into a different bottle/vessel one on top of the other to symbolise the new family unity. This vessel is then sealed to keep as reminder.
